Meridian, ID – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) has opened nominations for the 2010 *Leadership in Motion* awards. "These awards recognize businesses, individuals, and projects that have demonstrated leadership in supporting the Treasure Valley's regional long-range transportation plan, *Communities in Motion*," states Matt Stoll, COMPASS Executive Director. "They shine a spotlight on what *is* working and facilitate the sharing of good ideas."

The awards will recognize efforts and projects that occurred between July 2009 and June 2010. They will be presented on December 20, 2010, at the Nampa Civic Center during a COMPASS Board meeting.

Awards will be presented in the following categories:

- **Leadership by Example**, Ada County and Canyon County (two awards)  
These awards will be presented for projects that exemplify on-the-ground implementation of the goals described in *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership in Private Business**, Ada County and Canyon County (two awards)  
These awards will be presented to businesses and/or companies whose policies or work projects support the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership by Example**, Individual  
This award will be presented to an individual (not elected) who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to furthering the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership by Example**, Elected Official  
This award will be presented to an elected official who has demonstrated region-wide leadership in the areas of transportation and land use planning and whose leadership has helped further the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
