# COMPASS Seeks Nominations for *Leadership in Motion* Awards

*Meridian, ID* – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) is seeking nominations of businesses, individuals, and public projects that have demonstrated leadership in supporting the Treasure Valley's regional long-range transportation plan, *Communities in Motion*.

"This is the third year for our annual *Leadership in Motion* awards," states Matt Stoll, COMPASS Executive Director. "It is exciting to see the number and variety of nominations increase each year. We definitely have a lot going on in Ada and Canyon Counties worthy of recognition."

The awards will recognize efforts and projects that occurred between July 2010 and June 2011. They will be presented on December 19, 2011, at the Nampa Civic Center during a COMPASS Board meeting.

Awards will be presented in the following categories:

- **Leadership by Example**, Ada County and Canyon County (two awards)  
These awards will be presented for projects that exemplify on-the-ground implementation of the goals described in *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership in Private Business**, Ada County and Canyon County (two awards)  
These awards will be presented to businesses and/or companies whose policies or work projects support the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership by Example**, Individual  
This award will be presented to an individual (not elected) who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to furthering the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
- **Leadership by Example**, Elected Official  
This award will be presented to an elected official who has demonstrated region-wide leadership in the areas of transportation and land use planning and whose leadership has helped further the goals of *Communities in Motion*.
