Public Comment Requested on COMPASS Public Involvement Policy

Meridian, ID – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) requests public comment on its Public Involvement Policy.

The policy document, originally adopted by the COMPASS Board in 1994, provides general guidance for involving the public in the transportation planning process. The document is evaluated and updated, as appropriate, every three years. It was last updated in 2006.

COMPASS is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for Ada and Canyon Counties, with responsibility for transportation planning and allocation of federal transportation funding. The COMPASS Board consists of elected officials representing cities, counties, and highway districts in the two-county region.
