## Amendment to FY2007-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Northern Ada County and Nampa Urbanized Area –

Meridian -- The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) seeks public comment on proposed amendments to the FY2007-2011 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP) for Northern Ada County and the Nampa Urbanized Area from *May 30 through June 13, 2007*. Specifically,

### **PROJECT AMENDMENTS**

- Transit – Capital – new project to purchase vehicles to expand the demand response system.
- Transportation, Community, and System Preservation (TCSP) Group Projects – FY 2007 – Various agencies requested discretionary project(s) for award in summer 2007. Projects under this program provide a connection between transportation and land use. Funding is not guaranteed.
- Transit – Group projects for Section 5309 and 5339 – FY 2007 – Various agencies requested discretionary project(s) for award in summer 2007. Projects under this program provide capital improvements to the transit system. Funding is not guaranteed.
- I-84, Caldwell to Nampa – new project. ITD requested FY 2007 discretionary funds to widen I-84 between Caldwell and Nampa. Funding is not guaranteed.
- I-84, Franklin Blvd. Overpass Rebuild. This project will reconstruct the east half of the overpass to match the new bridge on the west side, and is part of the GARVEE-funded I-84 corridor improvements.
