## Amendment to FY2006-2010 Nampa Urbanized Area Transportation Improvement Program

The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) seeks public comment on an amendment to the FY2006-2010 Nampa Urbanized Area Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) from April 26 - May 12, 2006.

### PROJECT AMENDMENT

- Widen Amity Road from Chestnut Street to the ramps at the Kings Corner Overpass to a five-lane urban section
- \$10.75 million is available for this project
- The project is funded through Congressional High Priority Funds as identified in the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act—A Legacy for Users (SAFETE-LU), the new transportation bill signed in August 2005.

The City of Nampa will hold a public hearing on Monday, May 1, 2006 at 7:30 pm.
