

Stephanie Witt, Professor, Boise State University



Stephanie Witt, Ph.D. is the director of the Public Policy Center at Boise State University. She is also a professor in the Master of Public Administration program and director of the MPA Internship Program. Dr. Witt received her Ph.D from Washington State University in Pullman, Washington and began her career at Boise State in 1989 as a political science professor. She chaired the Political Science Department for six years, served as interim associate dean for the College of Social Sciences and Public Affairs and was Association Vice President for Academic Affairs for nearly six years. Dr. Witt received the Idaho Professor of the Year, Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of teaching and Council for Advancement and Support of Education in 1998 and was also awarded Outstanding Faculty by the Associated Students of Boise State University the same year. She has co-authored many books, including *Human Resource Management: The Public Service Perspective* and *The Urban West: Managing Growth and Decline*.
