Idaho's Share to Transportation

- 182 Million
- 50% of ITD's Share has to be allocated in 120 Days.
- 30% of the funds allocated regionally
- 30% to:
 - Urban TMA areas- (\$11.4 million to COMPASS)
 - Other areas proportionate to the state's population

Idaho's Share to Transportation

- Distributed funds will have a 1 year obligation requirement
- There is a 3 year time frame to complete projects
- There is an economically distressed communities preference, but according to ITD, only Blaine County, and the city of Parkline in Benewah County are not eligible
- 3% of the funds reserved for Enhancement

The Process for Distribution

- Governor Otter convened a panel of former Governor's and State Budget Officers to evaluate the Act.
- IT Board will meet March 3rd to finalize these recommendations
- Recommendations to the Governor to accept or reject
- Governor will then forward to the legislature for approval

How to distribute to the locals

- Option # 1 Use current methods adopted by LHTAC for prioritization, make recommendations to IT Board, projects are funded until funds are gone
- Option #2 Regional Distribution with Rating Criteria – Distribute 1.9 Million to the 6 districts
- Option #3 Rate the Current list of Projects – LHTAC would develop a criteria process, and have locals submit
- Option #4 First Come First Served. The first jurisdiction to submit would be funded until funds are exhausted.
