COMPASS to Host Online Event to Discuss Transportation Projects

Meridian, ID – The Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho (COMPASS) will be hosting an online, live Q&A event on [Facebook](#) to share information and answer questions about upcoming transportation projects in Ada and Canyon Counties.

The event is part of a larger effort to share information and receive feedback on federally funded transportation projects planned for the next five years and proposed changes to *Communities in Motion 2040*, the regional long-range transportation plan for Ada and Canyon Counties. These changes would both add and remove projects to be funded during the life of the *Communities in Motion* plan, including adding projects to widen portions of State Highway 44 and US Highway 20/26 (Chinden Boulevard).
